2024



The vineyards of Château Nénin are all in one piece, with the exception of one plot. The vines dedicated to the grand vin of Château Nénin are planted on the largest clay and gravel terroirs of the Pomerol plateau, covering about one third of the total vineyard. In the context of the Pomerol appellation, where it is rare for an estate to exceed 10 hectares, Château Nénin represents a major surface: up to 32 hectares of vines in production. Consequently, its terroir includes all the diversity of soils that characterise Pomerol. It is mainly made up of Oligocene deposits covered with gravelly alluvial formations of the Dordogne; siliceous clays and gravels, quartz, granites, iron dross as well as basalt pebbles.

VINTAGE 2024

The 2024 vintage tested the patience and resilience of the technical teams. From budbreak, unpredictable weather required constant vigilance and the ability to respond quickly. The rainy episodes in the spring followed by a relatively warm summer made vineyard management particularly challenging, calling for precise, well-timed decisions. The Merlots, harvested at peak ripeness, show vibrant freshness and silky tannins with impressive aromatic depth. The Cabernet Francs bring refined structure, floral notes, and excellent aromatic length. 2024 stands out for its balance & precision — the result of a demanding growing season and careful work from vine to cellar. It's a poised, expressive vintage that stays true to Pomerol's identity.
