



CHÂTEAU ROUGET 2024

Terroir

Gravelous soils mixed with clay. This soil composition, combined with an exceptional exposure, confers all the typicity, elegance and finesse to Château Rouget wines.

Grape Varieties

85% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Franc

Planting density: 3 000 vines per acre / 7 500 vines per hectare

Average age of vines: 40 years

Soil Management

During the dormancy of the vines, we do some plowing to force the roots to go deeper into the soil and we plant some selective seeds to protect our terroir from erosion. During spring, those seeds create a cover crop that offers both auto fertilization and natural protection from the heat. We do not cut those herbs we only roll or mow them.

Harvest

Harvest began on September 21st. Manual harvesting in 20 kg bins. Intra-parcel approach to ensure optimal ripeness. Densimetric sorting.

Winemaking & Ageing

Integral winemaking for 30% of the harvest, the remainder in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks
