The origins of Château Certan de May date back to the very beginnings of Pomerol. Gifted to the de May family by royal decree in the 16th century, the estate remained in their lineage until 1925, when it passed to the Barreau family.

Situated on Pomerol's central plateau, alongside renowned neighbors such as Vieux Château Certan and La Fleur-Pétrus, the estate benefits from a terroir where clay and gravel combine to create wines of both power and elegance, structure and freshness.

Jean-Luc Barreau, co-owner and director, applies all his care and attention to preserving the estate's heritage while refining its winemaking approach. Since the 2013 vintage, he has worked alongside renowned consultant Jean-Claude Berrouet to craft wines that reflect the estate's unique identity.

Château Certan de May produces rich, powerful, and complex wines. While they can be enjoyed after a few years of aging, their structure and natural depth ensure great longevity.
