AOC Pomerol

TERROIR

The vineyards of Château Nénin are all in one piece, with the exception of one plot. The vines dedicated to the grand vin of Château Nénin are planted on the largest clay and gravel terroirs of the Pomerol plateau, covering about one third of the total vineyard. In the context of the Pomerol appellation, the vines of Château Nénin cover a major potential surface. Consequently, its terroir includes all the diversity of soils that characterize Pomerol. It is mainly made up of Oligocene deposits covered with gravelly alluvial formations of the Dordogne; siliceous clays and gravels, quartz, granites, iron dross as well as basalt pebbles.

VINTAGE

Responsiveness and adaptability were the keys to the success of this 2022 vintage at Nénin. Each vintage is a lesson, with its characteristics, its difficulties, its questions and its successes. The nights cooled down at the beginning of April and led to the dreaded frost episodes. Thanks to the means of monitoring, the involvement of the teams and the late pruning, damage are limited. The spring, with little water and high temperatures, allowed the vines to develop well. The scorching summer quickly led to the first risks of water constraint, which were fortunately avoided by a small margin, and this is generally a sign of a remarkable vintage. The wines of 2022 are not at all marked by the extreme climatic characteristics. Indeed, freshness and roundness are present in the wines, thanks in particular to the resilience of our vineyards, able to adapt and evolve.
